




SUPPLIES

- *Petite Pocket Bigz XL Die
- *Crop a Dile
- *2 ½ circle Punch
- *Round Table Punch
- *1/16 Punch
- *Sticky Strip
- *Textured Impressions Folder (optional)
- *Itty Bitty Punch Pack
- *Cardstock for insert 2x3, 2x3 1/2 , 2x4
- *Scrap carstock for tab
- *cardstock to embellish front
- *length of ribbon, twine to tie all 3 pockets together
- *3 brads


STEP 1 – Cut 3 pockets using Petite Pocket Bigz XL Die




STEP 2 – Cut flaps from the end of each pocket



STEP 3 – Cut ½ Inch from open end of one pocket




STEP 4 – Cut 1 inch from open end of one pocket




STEP 5 – Punch notches in 2 pockets that do not have – Create a notch template using scrap paper and 2 ½ punch and the longest pocket which has notch from die)




STEP 6 – Assemble pockets using sticky tape



STEP 7 – Layer books with largest/longest on bottom ending with smallest on top



STEP 8 a/b – Use crop a dile to punch two holes at closed end



STEP 9 – Using ribbon, hemp, linen thread, twill – your choice tie pockets together.



STEP 10, 11, 12 – Use wheel to embellish inserts, use round tab punch, itty punch pack and brad to create tab on inserts



STEP 13 – Embellish cover as desired
