2 strips ¼" 6x12


2 strips ½" 6x12

**Cutting Tool** 

Bone Folder

Sticky Strip


STEP 1 & 2
Die Cut Fancy Favor Box - fold in half and texturize with Square Lattice Folder




STEP 2 – (Optional if you intend to use the create on the sides – mark a line as shown so you don't create slits into your crease area)



STEP 3 – Starting on vertical crease marks – use cutting tool or exacto knife to cut from top to line seen in blue box above. After cutting all creases – cut random size slits between these as seen above and here below




Step 4 – place sticky strip on left or right side (depends on if you work left to right or right to left- both ways work and are right!)




STEP 5 – adhere first strip (1/4 or  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch ) and begin weaving. Then choose next size and so on.

\*NOTE – you can increase the number of horizontal bands by cutting more thinner strips or you can decrease the


number by using less or cutting wider horizontal bands – the measurements I gave are for the basket in my sample)




STEP 6



STEP 7 – Carefully fold all creases gently with bone folder





STEP 8 – assemble fancy favor box using sticky strip for adhesive
