Follow the same guidelines for this ornament, but you'll only need 20 ornament cut outs since there are only 5 points on the green layer. (You'll also need 20 cut outs for the red layer of smaller ornaments)




Start with the bigger, green layer and build like the other ornament. While the hot glue is drying, assemble the red pieces together like in images A & B – they will be added to the green layer one at a time.

Once the glue is set on the green layer and you have your red ornaments are assembled, put hot glue at the top (flat end) of one red piece and attach to the glue puddle in the center. The red ornament should lay between two of the green ornaments at an angle. Continue adding the red ornaments until all 5 are attached.


Layer 6-8 dimensionals together in a stack to attach the rosette to the dried spot of hot glue.

Cut lengths of tulle about 3 scallops long, bunch at the center



Apply hot glue to the point of the tulle and insert in between two of the green ornaments.

Cute TEN 6" lengths of linen thread and use your glue gun and silicone craft sheet to make loops



Place two loops of linen threat onto the top of each green ornament, making sure to hide the ends.
