

Cardstock Trimmer punch


Designer Paper Chalktallk Framelits , rectangle or slit Stamp set of choice

Ribbon


STEP ONE – Cut one sheet of cardstock 4.25 x 8"




STEP TWO - Score card at 3"




STEP THREE – Cut another piece of cardstock 8" x 3.5"



STEP FOUR – Score at 4" (ok fold it in half)



STEP FIVE on the 8x3" piece add slits for gift card on one side



STEP SIX on side opposite the slits add a line of adhesive and then your ribbon




STEP SEVEN – Optional – add decorative element to edge of cardstock



STEP EIGHT – add contrasting piece of cardstock to top layer – trim to allow as much of the base color you desire to show



STEP NINE – working with the larger 8 x 4 ¼ piece Add contrasting Designer paper or cardstock to the 3" flap – again size to desired size



Step 10 – Add contrasting piece of cardstock or designere paper to 4.25x5.5 flap



STEP 11 – With fold facing right edge and opening facing the left edge adhere smaller embellished piece you created in steps 4-



STEP 12 – Open flap and fold done 3"flap to inside



STEP 13. Close right flap over and finish by embellishing top , adding gift card and tying bow
