Supplies

Stampin' UP!

Designer Paper 1 5/8 x 1 5/8

Designer Paper 6x6

Night of Navy Cardstock (for tag) 2 x 3.5

Whisper White Cardstock (for tag) 1 3/4 x 2 5/8

Scrap coordinating solid colors of cardstock for scallop and circle punches

1 3/4 scallop punch, 7/8 scallop punch, 1 3/8 circle punch

White Bakers Twine

Cherry Cobbler Bakers Twine

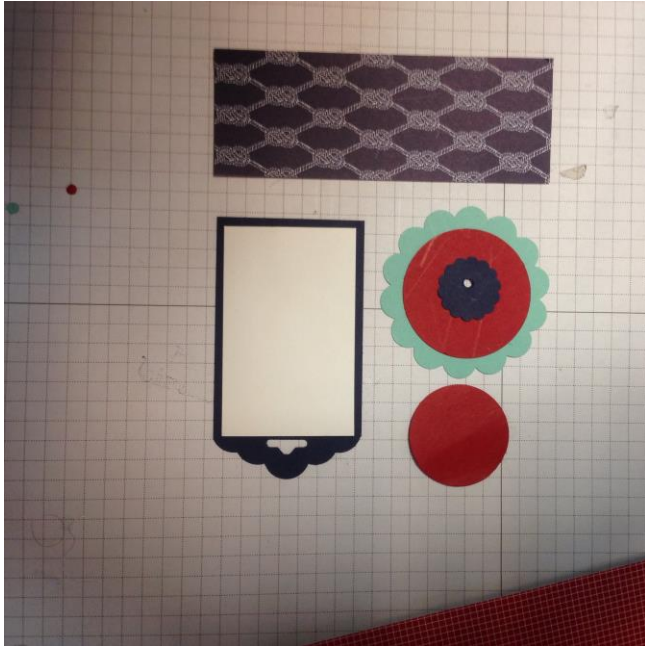
Silver Button

NO SU supplies

Hot glue gun

Dowels 1/8" diameter

Spool 2 1/4 x 1 1/2

1. Glue circle punch to bottom of spool
2. Glue punched scallop, circle, smaller circle together
3. Use hand held punch to punch 1/8 hole in center of pieces adhered together in number 2.
4. Adhere to other end of wooden spool
5. Create pinwheel with 6x6 piece of cs.
6. Create tag by punching the Night of navy piece of cs with scallop tag topper punch then layering white cs on top of piece just below opening created with the punch
7. Glue dowel to back of pinwheel and cover end with 1 1/4 circle shape
8. On front of pinwheel add bakers twine, smaller scallop circle punch and button embellishments.
9. Tie tag to dowel securing to dowel with small dab of hot glue
10. Insert dowel into hole on the punched scalloped/circle layered piece
