Supplies:

- Stamp Sets Petal Palette (145788) Timeless texture (140517)
- Card Stock Whisper White Cardstock (100731) Daffodil Delight Cardstock (119683)
- Stamp Pads Memento Black Ink (132708) Crumbcake (126975)
- Misc. Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blends Markers (144603) Old Olive Stampin' Blends Markers (144597) Stampin' Blends Color Lifter (144608) Old Olive 3/8" Mini Chevron Ribbon (144196) Very Vanilla ½" lace trim (141672)

Measurements:

- Whisper White Cardstock: 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"
- Old Olive Color Theory Designer paper: 4" x 5 ¼"
- Whisper White cardstock 3" x 3 ½"
- Daffodil Delight cardstock 3 ¼ x 3 ¾"

Instructions:

- 1. Score and fold 8 ½" piece of whisper white cardstock in half
- 2. Adhere 4" piece of old olive color theory designer paper to front of folded whisper white
- 3. Set these elements aside
- 4. Stamp rose image from Petal Palette using memento ink and allow to dry (you may use heat tool to dry faster)
- 5. Use the light and dark Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blends markers to color the roses
- 6. Use the Old Olive Stampin' Blends markers to color the leaves
- 7. Use the color lifter to lighten any areas to create more shading or remove any color from areas outside the lines
- 8. Add greeting as seen in photo

- 9. Ink up the dots from Timeless texture with crumbcake and stamp corners of piece with rose image
- 10. Cut 4 1/2" length of ribbon from the Old Olive and Very Vanilla Lace trims
- 11. Adhere these to the daffodil delight piece of cardstock
- 12. Adhere the colored rose image over top of the ribbon on the daffodil delight cardstock piece
- 13. Adhere the daffodil delight piece to the front of the card
- 14. Add greeting of choice or hand written note to inside of card
- 15. Slip into envelope and brighten a mailbox!
