Supplies:

- Stamp Sets Textured Notes (165548); Simply Said (163756)
- Card Stock Old Olive (100702); Basic White (166780); Pecan Pie (161717)
- Stamp Pads Pecan Pie (161665); Old Olive (147090)
- Misc. Woven Textures Designer Series Paper (DSP) (165560); Neutral Matte Dots (165561); Linen Thread (104199); Paper Snips (103579); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Stampin' SEAL (152813); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)

Measurements:

- Old Olive: 5 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" card base
- Basic White: 4 ³/₄" x 3 ¹/₂" layer, 3" x 3/8" for sentiment, 2 ¹/₂" x 3 ¹/₄" for leaf
- Pecan Pie: 3 1/8" x ³/₄"
- Woven Textures DSP: 3 pieces, one each in 3 different patterns: ³/₄" x 4 ¹/₂", 1" x 4 ¹/₂", and 1 ¹/₄" x 4 ¹/₂"
- Linen Thread: approx. 24"

Instructions:

- 1. Score the Old Olive card base on the long side at 4 ¹/₄" and fold.
- 2. Attach the three pieces of DSP to the Basic White layer from smallest to biggest using Stampin' SEAL to the Basic White $4 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " layer.
- 3. Stamp the basket weave image on the Pecan Pie piece of cardstock multiple times using Pecan Pie ink. Then, tear the cardstock on the long side to distress the piece a bit.
- 4. Add the torn Pecan Pie piece to the center of the card front using Stampin' SEAL.
- 5. Stamp the leaf image on the Basic White $2\frac{1}{2}$ x $3\frac{1}{4}$ layer using Old Olive ink.
- 6. Hand cut the leaf image using Paper Snips. Add a bit of Stampin' SEAL to the backside of the leaf image and loop Linen Thread a few times behind the image and press onto the Stampin' SEAL.

- 7. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back and add to the card front over the Pecan Pie strip.
- 8. Stamp the sentiment from Simply Said on the Basic White strip using Pecan Pie ink.
- 9. Add the sentiment to the card front using Liquid Glue.
- 10. Lastly, add three Neutral Matte Dots to the card to finish.
