

Cute as a Bug Card

Supplies:

- **Paper** –Thick Basic White (159229); Basic White (168780); Cloud Cover (165621); Cute as a Bug Designer Series Paper (166994)
- **Stamp Pads** – Pecan Pie (161665)
- **Misc.** – Moody Palette Glossy Dots (167180); Old Olive 3/8" Specialty Rickrack (167006); Early Espresso & Old Olive Linen Thread (165986); Blending Brushes (153611); 2-3/8" Circle Punch (161354); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Measurements:

- Thick Basic White: 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" scored at 4-1/4"
- Cute as a Bug DSP: 3" x 4" (cut from the cut apart sheet) and a fussy cut critter
- Basic White: 2-3/8" circle
- Cloud Cover: 3-1/8" x 4-1/8"
- Olive Ribbon: 4"

- Linen Thread: 8"

Instructions :

1. Using pecan pie ink and a blending brush, ink around the edges of the card base, circle and 3" x 4" piece of dsp.
2. Distress around the edges of the 3" x 4" piece of dsp using scissors. Add this piece to the cloud cover card stock.
3. Wrap the olive rickrack around the dsp and adhere it to the back using mini glue dots.
4. Add the circle to the dsp and trim off the excess.
5. Add this piece to the center of the card front.
6. Add the bug to the card front using dimensionals.
7. Feed the olive twine under the ribbon and tie a bow.
8. Finish off with three old olive glossy dots.
