

# Easter Basket

## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Easter Basket Stamp Set (166940); Easter Basket Bundle (166947)
- **Paper** – Basic White (166780); Balmy Blue (146982); Crumb Cake (120953); Early Espresso (119686); Pecan Pie (161717); Flirty Flamingo (141416); Shy Shamrock (163795); Easter Joy 12" x 12" Specialty Designer Series Paper (166939)
- **Stamp Pads** – Balmy Blue (147105); Early Espresso (147114)
- **Misc.** – Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Paper Trimmer (152392); Bone Folder (102300); Everyday Arches Dies (164629); Blending Brushes (153611); Wink of Stella (141897); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin Seal (152813); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Removable Tape (non-SU); scissors (non-SU)

## Measurements:

- Balmy Blue: 8 ½" x 5 ½"; scored at 4 ¼"
- Designer Series Paper: 4" x 3"
- Basic White: 4 ½" x 3 ½"
- Crumb Cake: 4" x 3"
- Pecan Pie: 3" x 1 ½"
- Flirty Flamingo: 3" x 2"
- Early Espresso: 2" x 1 ½"
- Shy Shamrock: 2 ½" x ¾"
- Designer Series Paper: scrap
- Basic White: 3 ½" x ¾"



## Instructions

1. Fold the Balmy Blue cardstock in half on the score line to form the card base.
2. Attach the 4" x 3" Designer Series Paper to the bottom of the front of the card.
3. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out an arch from the 4 ½" x 3 ½" Basic White cardstock using the Everyday Arches Dies.
4. Use a Blending Brush to add some Balmy Blue ink to the middle of the die-cut arch.
5. Attach the arch to the middle of the front of the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.

6. Stamp the bunny image on the Early Espresso cardstock with Early Espresso cardstock.
7. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, die-cut out the following (with the coordinating dies):
  - The stamped bunny from the stamped Early Espresso cardstock
  - The easter basket from the Crumb Cake cardstock
  - The basket lines for the Easter Basket from the Pecan Pie cardstock
  - The bow and the ruffle from the Flirty Flamingo cardstock
  - The grass from the Shy Shamrock cardstock
  - The six eggs from the scrap piece of Designer Series Paper
8. Weave the basket lines into the Easter Basket cuts, alternating the layers.
9. Attach the basket to the middle of the arch with Stampin' Dimensionals (on the basket) and with Multipurpose Glue on the handle.
10. Add some Wink of Stella to the die-cut bunny.
11. Attach the grass to the bottom of the basket.
12. Attach the ruffle to the top edge of the basket.
13. Lay out the eggs and the bunny inside the basket. Attach some with Stampin' Seal and some with Stampin' Dimensionals.
14. Use the Bone Folder to curl the ends of the bow.
15. Attach the bow to the basket handle.
16. Stamp the greeting on the long piece of Basic White cardstock with Early Espresso ink.
17. Use scissors to cut the greeting in half, then cut each end at an angle.
18. Attach the greeting to the inside of the card.
