Supplies:

- Stamp Sets – Sweet Bugs Bundle (166050)
- Cardstock & Paper – Old Olive (100702) Basic Beige (164511), Basic White (166780), Darling duckling (165622), Cute as a Bug Designer Series Paper (DSP) (166994)
- Stamp Pads – Memento Black (132708)
- Misc. – Stampin' Blends in Old Olive (154892) and Highland Heather (154887), Sparkle Dot Essentials (166991), Specialty Rickrack (167006), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755), Mini Glue dots (103683), Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, scissors

Measurements:

- Old Olive: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" card base
- Basic Beige: 4 1/8" x 3 1/8" layer
- Basic White: 3/8" x 2 1/2" and 1 1/2" x 2"
- Cute as a Bug DSP: 3" x 4" preprinted piece from pack + 4 1/4" x 2 1/2"
- Rickrack: 4 1/4"

Instructions:

1. Score the Old Olive card base on the long side at 4 1/4" and fold.
2. Attach the 4 1/4" x 2 1/2" DSP to the bottom of the card front using liquid glue.
3. Attach a 4 1/4" piece of Rickrack in the center of the card front using Mini Glue Dots.
4. Attach the Basic Beige cardstock and 3" x 4" preprinted piece from the pack of DSP together using liquid glue.

- 5.** Attach that to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 6.** Die cut the three little bugs using a scrap of Darling Duckling cardstock. Attach them to the preprinted piece using liquid glue.
- 7.** Stamp the bug on Basic White cardstock using Memento Black ink. Color the bug using the Stampin' Blends listed. Then, die cut using the coordinating die.
- 8.** Add the bug to the tree stump on the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 9.** Stamp the sentiment on the Basic White strip using Memento Black ink. Flag the end of the sentiment using scissors.
- 10.** Add the sentiment to the card front using liquid glue.
- 11.** Lastly, use three Sparkle Dots to the front.
